

Product Lifecycle Policy


G.M. International's ("GMI") Product Lifecycle Policy ("Policy"), describes the sequence of states its products go through. These are shown in the following table:

Obsolete	<p>The product is:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Not manufacturable. • Displayed on GMI website with indication of state. • Not included in any "Price List". • Not available for sale. • Not covered by GMI Technical Support. 	-
